

Asbury Goodknight Cemetery

Flat Creek (?) Township – Section 2.

Flat Creek TWP 44N, Range 21W, Section 2 (SE of NE)—located off a gravel road, south of F and east of U (Note: I attempted to visit this cemetery on 18 August 2009, but the entrance was overgrown. Will have to attempt in winter). I visited this cemetery on 5 March 2010. The walkway to the cemetery was clear and the cemetery was accessible. Took pictures of all of the stones except for three.

DAR: This family cemetery is located in Flat Creek TWP, Pettis Co., MO, in Section 2, TWP 45, R21. This location is about 6 ½ miles south of Sedalia, MO, and is on the farm owned now (1952) by Ted Welliver. Michael Goodknight's wife, Comfort, was the daughter of Captain George McCormick, who served in the Revolutionary War from Virginia. He later moved to Mercer Co., KY, where he died. Michael and Comfort Goodknight were the parents of twelve children. Three of them, John, Elizabeth, and Napoleon are buried in this cemetery with their parents. Begin at Hwy 65 & F (Anderson School Road). East on F about 3.5+ miles to Hendrickson Road connecting from the south. Turn right approx .3 mile. On the east side of the road is a gate and small sign that says, "Asbury Goodknight Cemetery."
